JESUS the Prince of Peace Text: Isaiah 9:6 Bill Turner

Providing peace with God, peace with ourselves and peace with others

- 1. I love the ocean, but I fear the ocean...
 - a. I heard stories of the \$ guys would make working the fishing boats in Alaska...
 - b. but I also heard of the storms on the Bearing Sea... water so cold you only survive 7 min.
 - c. The last place I would want to be is caught in a storm on the bering sea...
- 2. It also means that I completely understand the fear of the disciples caught in a maelstrom on sea of Galilee... when Jesus was asleep in the boat (Mk 4:35–41)
 - a. The Prince of Peace Told the Stormy Sea, 'Peace, Be Still'... and the Wind ceased and there was a Great Calm!
- 3. Jesus is called The Price of Peace (Isaiah 9:6)

I. THE NEED FOR PEACE

A. CONFLICT BETWEEN PEOPLE

- 1. Since sin first entered the world there has been Conflict Everywhere...
 - a) You can't check the news for 5 min without hearing of domestic abuse, children neglected, a shooting or abduction, missing persons cases.
 - b) The F.B.I reports 2020 had the **biggest spike in murders** in American history —30%. That's 5,000 more Americans murdered in 2020 than yr before
 - c) By Comparison, the violent year of **1968 had a 12% increase in murders 2020 had a 30% increase** (Heritage Foundation 10/7/21)
- 2. It spills into open conflict between populations and political groups...

 Constant Lying, Sabotage, Character Assassination, Political Assassination...
- 3. It spills into open conflict between nations...

Wars and Rumors of Wars, Hatred and Strife, Conflict and Confusion.

- 4. But it's NOT Just in the NEWS NOT Just in Politics or Geo-Politics... IT'S IN OUR OWN HOMES AND MARRIAGES!
 - a) Conflict Over Money and Finances...
 - b) Conflict Over Children
 - c) Conflict Over Chores... Family Responsibilities... and Pressure from Work
 - d) Conflict Over Relatives... Conflict over Personalities....
 - e) Conflict over Misunderstanding... Disagreements... Unrealistic Expectations
 - f) Conflict Over Time, Entertainment, over Religious Faith and Commitment to God
 - g) Conflicts on Social Media, Conflicts Between Neighbors

B. CONFLICT WITHIN OURSELF

- Conflict is not just in our cities or our homes—it is WITHIN US!
 Conflict in our own heart
 - a) Guilt, Shame, Regret over the sins and mistakes of our past...

- b) Conflict of Broken Relationships and hurt feelings
- c) Between fathers & sons... mothers & daughters... Father-in-laws & Mother-in-laws
- d) failed relationships, failed families, failed marriages
- 2. The Anger, resentment, bitterness of how others treated us...

or how our life did not turn out the way we wanted or expected

- a) A Huge Spike in Depression and Anxiety—especially among Teens...
- b) Social Media Peer Pressure,... Online Isolation... Online Bullying...
- c) FACEBOOK ENVY, FEAR OF MISSING OUT, Instagram cult of beauty...

C. CONFLICT BETWEEN OURSELF AND GOD

- 1. Even in times of Peace there is war... because without God ruling the throne of our heart there is no peace (James 4:1–4)
- 2. Even the ancient philosophers and thinkers recognized this...1
 - a) The Greek satirist, Lucian wrote: 'All the evils which come upon man—revolutions and wars, stratagems and slaughters—spring from desire. All these things have as their fountain-head the desire for more.'
 - b) **Plato** writes: 'The sole cause of wars and revolutions and battles is nothing other than the body and its desires.'
 - c) Cicero, the Roman orator, writes: 'It is insatiable desires which overturn not only individual men, but whole families, and which even bring down the state. From desires there spring hatred, schisms, discords, seditions and wars.'
- 3. Worldly, Selfish People Are Never Happy—and Never WILL be Happy...

 Because they are driven by an insatiable desire for more

'No One Is Free Who is a Slave To their Own Flesh' (Seneca)

4. The Flesh fights against the spirit—the Spirit is fighting against God

II. THE PRINCE OF PEACE

A. PEACE WITH GOD

- 1. We Were Enemies of God—because of our sin & rebellion against Him
 - a) We Were under the Penalty and Condemnation of Sin
- 2. But God Did Something So Amazing that No One Else Could Do...
 - a) God allowed His Holy wrath against sin to be poured out onto His Son on the cross so you won't face His wrath on Judgement Day (Romans 5:6-10)
- 3. So Those With Faith enough to Trust and Obey—Can Have Peace with God through Jesus Christ! (5:1-2)

B. PEACE WITHIN OURSELF

- 1. Now There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ (Rom 8:1)
 - a) That word NO Means NONE...
 - b) Not a fraction, Not a molecule... Not a hint of condemnation

2. We Stand Before God Forgiven, Sanctified, Pure because of His blood

- a) The Guilt, the Shame, the Regret... The Broken Relationships...

 The Fear, the Anxiety, the Worry
- b) Are Replaced with Forgiveness by Grace
- 3. We Are Now Free to Live by the Spirit as opposed to the flesh (Rom 8:5–6)

C. PEACE WITH OTHERS

- 1. The Kingdom of God is a Kingdom of Peace! (Ephesians 2:12–15)
 - a) Because God has forgiveness us of our sins
 - b) Breaking Down the Walls and Trenches and Barbed Wire of our Hearts
 - c) And Making us a Kingdom of Priests who are now at peace!
- 2. We Are to be Peace Makers—Not Trouble Makers!
 - a) Ambassadors of Peace, sharing the Peace of Christ w/ World! (Romans 12:14–18)

III. THE BLESSINGS OF PEACE

A. WE HAVE A PEACE THE WORLD DOES NOT HAVE (Jn 14:27)

- 1. The World Tries to Sell You Peace but it's a counterfeit peace!
 - a) I notice that the 24/7 News Media Gets us All Jacked Up on Anxiety over BREAKING NEWS: the Sky is Falling!!...
 - b) Then They Advertise Products for the Anxiety They Are Shooting Into Your Veins!
- 2. But True Peace is only available through Jesus Christ...
- 3. Jesus is the Prince of Peace who has overcome the world! (John 16:33)

B. <u>WE HAVE A PEACE THE WORLD DOESN'T UNDERSTAND</u> <u>A PEACE THAT SURPASSES UNDERSTANDING</u> (Phil 4:6-7)

- 1. How do You Describe Something indescribable?

 How do you understand something beyond understanding?
- 2. Even if you can't describe it, or understand it—you can EXPERIENCE It
- 3. Jesus experienced acute anxiety in the garden—sweat as drops of blood
- 4. He fell to His knees praying intensely 3x the cup of suffering could pass
- 5. But He Submitted to the Will of His Father—and from that point forward Jesus was the Calm in the center of the Storm

C. A PEACE THAT GUARDS YOUR HEART AND MIND THROUGH JESUS

- 1. ALL SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS ARE IN CHRIST!
 - a) Our Joy... Our Peace... Our Salvation... Our Eternal Home in Heaven
- 2. We Are Never Alone... We Know Who Wins... We Know Who Provides...
- 3. We Know All Things Work Together for Good to those who love the Lord
- 4. We Know Nothing Can Separate Us From the Love of God in Christ Jesus
